Summary:

The Conduit Handler prepares the conduit to hold the electrical component of hospital patient service systems. The conduit is measured, cut and prepared using parts drawings, supervisor instructions, and visual samples.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Read and interpret drawings, sketches and written/verbal work instructions to determine conduit requirements for the unit.
- Measure conduit according to specifications.
- Cut conduit tubing using a band saw
- Bend conduit tubing according to specifications with a conduit bender
- Ream the tubing with a reaming tool to remove any burrs formed during the cutting process
- Other tasks as assigned by supervisor
- Follow all procedures and work instructions as documented by the Quality System
- Report and/or document any Quality problems with products or procedures to supervisor or Quality personnel
- Suggest improvements to product design and/or procedures/work instructions as needed
- Comply with Company's regular and timely attendance requirements

- Able to read a tape measure
- Fluent in the English language

Physical Demands:
